TOPICS DISCUSSED

Review from previous meeting. JSP reviewed with members the topics discussed at the previous Steering Committee Meeting.

Project Update: Tier I Data Collection. JSP is working to collect data from sites across the state. Discussed the need to collect data from more agencies, especially those included in OSPS Year 1.

Project Update: Operations Workgroup. JSP reviewed the discussion from April 12, 2022. These topics included the purpose of the workgroup and expectations, important topics around the tools' development, engaging jurisdictions without pretrial units, important factors for pretrial bond reports, and existing practices members have found successful to implement new practices.

PROJECT REQUESTS

Tier I existing data. We need existing data on those booked into local jails. Most importantly we need criminal history data. Contact JSP to set up a time to talk about participating.

Volunteers to collect Tier II data. Anyone interested in potentially collecting pretrial support data should contact JSP.

Operations workgroup members. This group will be line staff in probation, jails, and courts to provide context and discussion around operations within agencies to guide development and implementation. Contact JSP to add individuals to this group.
